What is a Contest?

A contest occurs any time multiple Politicians are competing in a Promotion, Election, or National Event. Players participate in a contest by supporting or opposing the contestants.

Support

Supporting a Politician means playing an Action Card or Standard Action that benefits a contestant or penalizes an opponent. Use green markers for support and red markers for opposition.

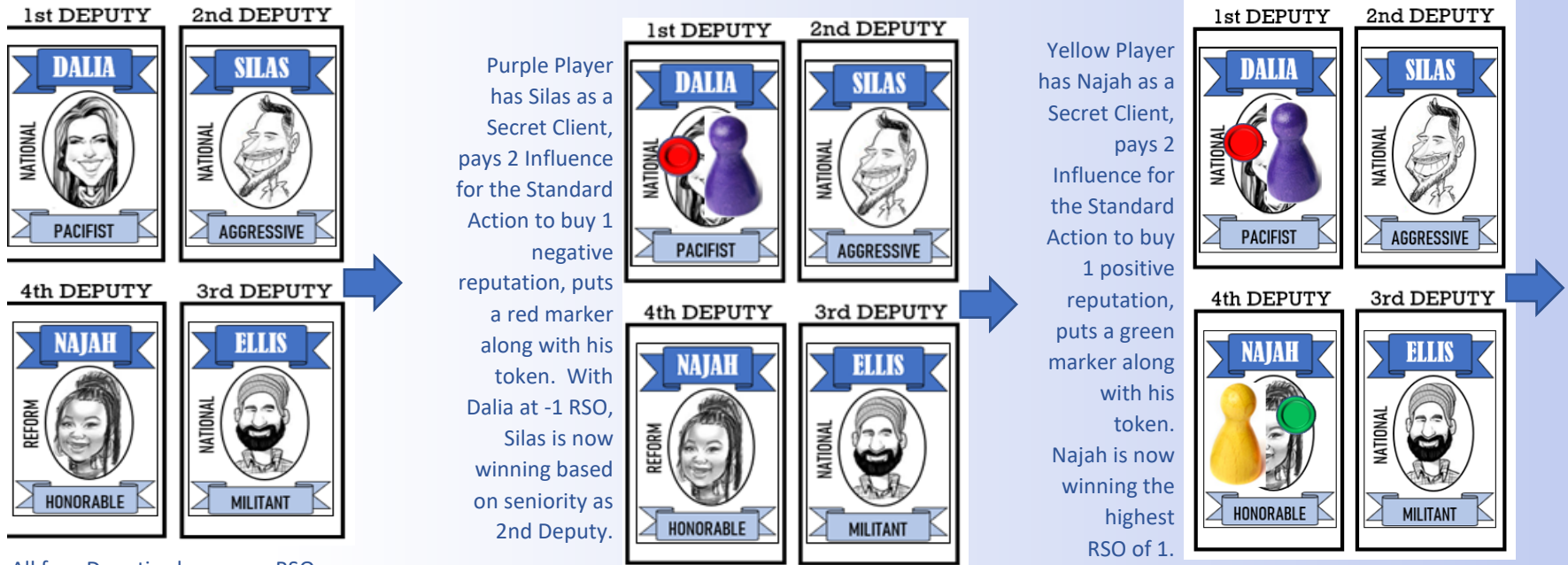
The first player to support a Minister places their token on the 1st Supporter circle, and earns 1 Victory Point if this side wins. The second player takes the 2nd Supporter circle, and earns 1 Influence marker if this side wins.

Oppose

Opposing is the reverse, playing an Action card or Standard Action that penalizes a contestant or benefits an opponent. Use red markers for opposition and green markers for support.

The first player to oppose a Minister places their token on the 1st Supporter circle, and earns 1 Victory Point if this side wins. The second player takes the 2nd Supporter circle, and earns 1 Influence marker if this side wins.

Deputies have a limit of 1 token. The first player to Support or Oppose places their token on the Deputy's card if there is not yet a token present. If your side wins, you gain 1 Influence marker.



All four Deputies have zero RSO.
Dalia is winning based on seniority as 1st Deputy.
